*The Clarkston area is defined as the Clarkston Community Schools attendance area, but private or homeschooled students living within the attendance area may apply.

Number of scholarships and amount vary yearly. (in the past \$1,000 ,\$1,500, \$2,000)

Minimum GPA: not required

The Clarkston Farm and Garden Club, a 501c3 non-profit organization which has worked to improve the Village of Clarkston and Independence Township through beautification and education for over 70 years.

The club, which was initiated in 1948, provides education and beautification efforts in the Clarkston community.

The club provides mini grants to teachers, student assemblies and college scholarships for students. Clarkston Farm and Garden Club plants and takes care of the Clarkston Independence District Library gardens, the Clarkston Village planters, and holds a Perennial Plant Exchange for the community, yearly.

The club also supports the Clarkston Family Farm, and two additional community farms which provide produce for Gleaners, as well as the Oakland County 4-H Fair, and the area Land Conservancy.
